KWiSE (Korean Women in Science and Engineering) is a non-profit organization of Korean-American women professionals in the science and engineering fields. Our mission is:

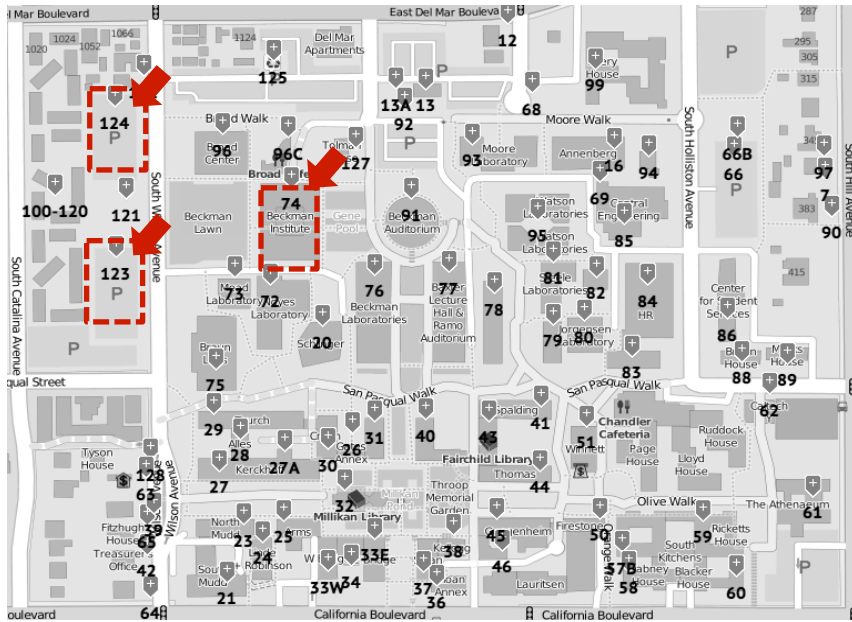
- (1) To establish and strengthen the network of Korean-American women scientists and engineers
